



## SurfStitch Class Action Update

### IMPORTANT NOTICE TO GROUP MEMBERS

### Proceedings 2017/193375 & 2017/347082

**18 November 2019**

On 12 November 2019 the Supreme Court of New South Wales ordered the publication of the Notice to Group Members (**Annexure D**) published on our homepage for the attention of persons who held an interest in shares in SurfStitch Group Ltd (Subject to DOCA)(ASX Ticker: SRF) on any of 25 February 2016, 3 May 2016, or 9 June 2016.

If you are such a person, then you are potentially a group member in the SurfStitch Class Actions, and may have received the Notice via post or email detailed above. If you have not received the Notice via post or email, please download same via our home page for your review. Please review Part E of the notice carefully to check whether you may be a group member.

Take notice that the parties to the SurfStitch Class Actions have agreed on terms for settlement of the SurfStitch Class Actions. In order to take effect, the settlement must be approved by the Court. The Plaintiffs have applied to the Court for approval, which will be heard on **16 December 2019**.

If you fit the description of a 'group member', then you should take notice that the Court has made orders setting a deadline by which you can register to make a claim for compensation, opt out of the SurfStitch Class Actions, or object to the settlement. If you neither opt out nor register you are likely to lose your right to claim compensation in respect of the claims covered by the SurfStitch Class Actions. Please read the Annexure D Notice carefully for all your options.

The deadline for registering to participate in the settlement, opting out, or objecting to the settlement is **4pm AEDT on 11 December 2019 (Participation Deadline)**.

Please review our home page, and previous updates for more details about the SurfStitch Class Actions. If you fit the description of a 'group member', you should review Annexure D immediately, and decide what to do well before the Participation Deadline.
